

Arki/Arketek (1989)

The project was created and built for the design competition entitled "Inventing the Future," in collaboration with Pino Trogu and was considered one of the best entries.

Arketek Ludens is a digital "Lego-world" (prior to unsuccessful attempts by the Lego company to go digital). Various element (bricks) go into assembling images, sounds, motion sequences, and tactile experiences. Children construct a world that incorporates all their senses and actively acquire new experiences instead of learning in a passive mode.

Arketek Faber follows the same principle, i.e., engaging all the senses, and is intended to aid creativity for multimedia design.
